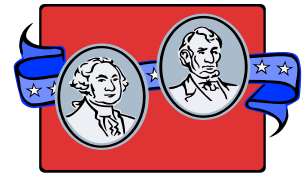

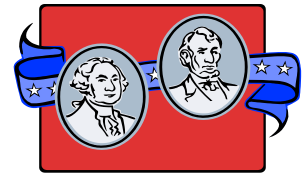

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Flu Precautions

Children's immune systems are less mature than those of adults are so they're more susceptible to germs. Beechwood is taking extra precautions by special cleaning & disinfecting the toys and rooms. Also, we continue to encourage good habits by the children.

It would be appreciated if you could practice and discuss the following good health habits.

- Washing hands with soap & water when returning home from school and other outings.
- Avoid touching face, esp. eyes, nose & mouth.
- Encouraging your child to sneeze in their sleeve or into a tissue. *Discourage covering mouth with hands while coughing & sneezing.*
- Not allowing the sharing of cups, utensils, towels, toothbrushes, etc.
- Making special efforts for your child to get plenty of sleep during flu season.
- Keeping your child home with a fever and until no fever-reducing drugs are needed for 24 hrs.
- Encouraging drinking lots of fluids

Note, the CDC states that people are contagious until 5-7 days after the onset of flu symptoms.
