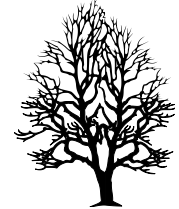


The Beechwood School November Newsletter

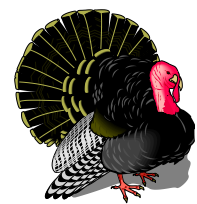
