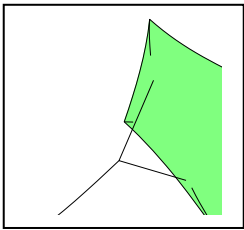


The Beechwood School March Newsletter

Dear Parents,

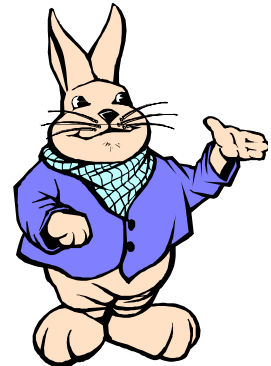
February has flown by and believe it or not Spring is right around the corner.
